Happy New Year, नववर्ष की मंगलकामनाएँ

Dear Devotees.

The Ramayana Centre is pleased to present its annual calendar of 2025, themed 'Dialogues of Śrī Rāma.' Śrī Rāma is engaged in conversations with nearly all the characters in the Ramayana, offering profound values, insights, and teachings. We have selected dialogues with twelve different characters, corresponding to the twelve months of the year.

As we have only 12 sheets on the calendar, we had to limit the dialogues only to 12 characters which have been presented in the order they appear in the Ramcharitmanas.

We pray Bhagwan Rām to guide us on the right path and bless us with His Divine Grace.

- 1.Śrī Rāma to Vishvamitra: With King Dashrath's permission, Sage Vishvamitra took Śrī Rāma and Lakshman to protect his yagna from demons. Śrī Rāma killed the demoness Tadaka with a single arrow. Consequently, the sage blessed Śrī Rāma and presented him with divine, unfailing weapons. He then began his yajna while Śrī Rāma and Lakshman safeguarded the rituals.
- 2. Śrī Rāma to Lakshman : Śrī Rāma and Lakshman went to King Janaka's garden to pluck flowers for Sage Vishvamitra's prayers. By divine design, Devi Sita too arrived there to pray to Mata Parvati. When Śrī Rāma saw her, he fell in pure love with her, and shared his feelings with Lakshman.
- 3. Śrī Rāma to Sage Parshuram: At Devi Sita's swayamvar, Śrī Rāma broke Sri Shiva's Pinak bow. Hearing this, an enraged Sage Parshuram confronted him. Śrī Rāma's calm demeanor and soft words pacified the Sage, who eventually realized Śrī Rāma was none other than Sri Vishnu incarnate.
- 4. Śrī Rāma to Mata Kaikeyi : Mata Kaikeyi, misled by her maid Manthara. demanded two boons from King Dashrath, first that Bharat be crowned king and second, Śrī Rāma to be exiled for fourteen years. Śrī Rāma accepted her wish unquestioningly, saying it was a son's duty to obey his parents.
- 5. Śrī Rāma to Mata Kausalya: After Mata Kaikeyi's decree, Śrī Rāma informed

his mother, Mata Kausalya, of his exile. She was shocked and shattered but Śrī Rāma consoled her, saying that it was his duty to abide by the command of his father. He then reassured Mata Kausalya that he would return after fulfilling his father's command.

- 6. Śrī Rāma to King Dashrath: Śrī Rāma, with Devi Sita and Lakshman, sought King Dashrath's blessings before leaving for exile. Heartbroken, Dashrath pleaded with him to stay, but Śrī Rāma alleviated his pain and upheld his duty.
- 7. Śrī Rāma to Sumantra: Sumantra, King Dashrath's charioteer, escorted Śrī Rāma to the forest till Shringaverpur. Before Śrī Rāma further entered the forest to spend the fourteen years, he beseeched Śrī Rāma to return to Ayodhya with him, as this was King Dashrath's wishes. Śrī Rāma, however, gently declined, emphasizing that it was particularly more important for him to obey his father.
- 8. Śrī Rāma to Bharat: Bharat, along with Ayodhya's citizens, visited Chitrakoot pleading Sri Ram to return. Bharat had even planned the coronation of Śrī Rāma in Chitrakoot itself, but Śrī Rāma declined. He praised Bharat's virtues and his devotion to dharma.
- 9. Śrī Rāma to Jatayu: As Ravana abducted Sita, Jatayu fought valiantly to stop him. Seriously injured, Jatayu rushed to Śrī Rāma and informed him of Sita's abduction, before passing away. Śrī Rāma honoured Jatayu's loyalty and sacrifice.
- 10. Śrī Rāma to Hanuman: During his search for Sita, Śrī Rāma met Hanuman, Sugriv's minister. Recognizing Śrī Rāma as, his Śrī Hanuman bowed down at His lotus feet and pledged that he will remain faithful, loyal and will always devotedly serve Śrī Rāma. He played a pivotal role in helping Śrī Rāma rescue Sita.
- 11. Śrī Rāma to Sugriva: Śrī Rāma allied with Sugriva as a friend to rescue Sita. He elaborated on the qualities of a true friend and promised to defeat Sugriva's rival, Vali, in exchange for Sugriva's help. After fulfilling his promise, Sugriva mobilized his forces to assist Śrī Rāma.
- 12. Śrī Rāma to Vibhishan: Vibhishan surrendered to Śrī Rāma after failing to persuade his brother Ravana to return Devi Sita to Śrī Rāma. Despite skepticism from others, Śrī Rāma welcomed him. It highlights the compassionate nature of Śrī Rāma who accepts anyone who comes to His refuge.
